Essential Structures to Support Pretrial Justice Reform

- Legal Structure to Support the Purpose of Bail
- Essential Elements Pretrial Justice System in place
- System Supports a Dedicated Pretrial Services Agency
- Organizational Capacity- Adaptive Change vs, Technical Change



Essential Elements of a Pretrial System

- 1. Guiding principle of bail decisions based on risk
 - Appearance
 - Public Safety
 - Release
 - Three M's
- 2. Release options following arrest
 - Cite and Release
 - Summons vs. Warrant
 - Diversion
- 3. Legal Scheme to support in or out decision immediately effectuated



Essential Elements of a Pretrial System

- 4. Speedy prosecutorial case screening
 - Options for diversions
 - No charge
 - Specialty Courts
- 5. Delegated Release Authority
 - Early
 - Limited
 - Risk Based not Money Based
- 6. Initial appearance timeliness and meaningful
 - Defense
 - Prosecutor
 - Judge

Essential Elements of a Pretrial System

- 7. Dedicated Pretrial Services Agency/Function
- ✓ Operationalized Mission
- ✓ Universal Screening
- ✓ Utilize Validated Pretrial Risk Assessment
- ✓ Differential Supervision
- ✓ Performance Measurement and Feedback
